

Technical Visit to T-Park

This was the third Technical Visit organized by Young Professionals Network of Energy Institute - HK Branch in 2019. There were 22 delegates participating in such visit on 24 August 2019.



Upon arrival at the park, we were lead to the T-Theatre which ran an introductory video of T-PARK which gave visitors an overview of the facility. The video highlighted the significant contributions of the park to continuous drive to shape Hong Kong's "waste-to-energy" ambitions for the good of the community, and how the concept of waste management, resource recovery and recycling were applied in Hong Kong. And then, the participants were guided through a tour to learn about the sludge treatment processes for electricity generation, and the desalination process for production of potable water.



After the tour guide, all participants were given a free time to walkthrough different indoor / outdoor facilities like T-Cafe, T-Roof, T-Gallery, T-.Sky, T-Garden, T-Habitat and T-Spa. We hardly believed that the Park was actually a self-sustaining waste-to-energy plant
